



Minutes from meeting of Nov. 5, 2018

Present: 6 Board Members with 19 total attendees

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Randy B.

The Treasurers Report was read and approved.

The minutes of last month's meeting were read and approved

Old Business:

- The Club has an engraved commemorative Henry 22 Golden Boy rifle that will be raffled off when 100 tickets are sold. The proceeds are earmarked for range improvements and tickets are \$10 apiece. The rifle may be inspected and tickets are available at Carson Guns.
- The suggestion was made to begin installing the concrete target bases at the rifle range in pairs during regular hours, without the necessity of a range closure. The idea met with approval and the first installation should take place shortly. The Club is planning to schedule a work party for general maintenance and clean-up in the late winter/spring of 2019. - The Carson City Parks/Recreation Department has not signed the paperwork for an NRA Range Assessment as yet, and the Club is planning to initiate the process on its own if the delays in approval on the part of the City persist. The Carson City chapter of the NNIDPA has offered to split the cost of the survey if this comes to pass. The City has presented the Club with a request for an Operating Plan for the rifle and pistol range that is quite extensive, including a plan for volunteer RSOs that may prove difficult to meet. A meeting with the City is scheduled for November 27. One or two Board members who may wish to attend this meeting should contact Randy Brooks for further information.

- Changes in policies at Casino Fandango will result in the Club having to pay in advance for its annual holiday dinner and meeting on January 3rd, 2019. A separate announcement will be made in a couple of weeks and members will be asked to RSVP at that time. Stay tuned for further details...
- Last month the Club staged its first 300 yard rifle match, which was attended by seven shooters. The 3x300 rifle match is along the same lines as the current 3x200 match- 3 stages of 15 shots each, for a total of 45 shots plus sighters. One more of these matches will be held this year, on Saturday December 29.
